

Planet Ocean The new show takes you into the largely unknown depths of the world's oceans. Using large-format photographs and films - some never publicly seen before - the exhibition reveals not only the fascinating beauty of this complex ecosystem but also its diverse life forms, from the dancing harlequin octopus to the cute sea lion. By contrast, the consequences of human activity are documented in harrowing images of overfishing, coral bleaching, or species extinction.

The Wave The immersive production "The Wave" creates the dramaturgical highlight of the exhibition. A 40-metre high and 18-metre wide screen in the shape of a wave serves as a projection surface for an animated underwater world. From the giants of the seas to small schools of fish - the fascinating marine worlds developed by Ars Electronica Solutions and the highend projection technology by Epson give visitors the feeling of being underwater.

Endangered seas Oceans are energy suppliers, transport routes, and food sources and produce most of the oxygen that is so vital for humans. The new show also deals with the threatening destruction of this particularly important marine habitat; however, it also shows ways out of the crisis. "Planet Ocean" is an exhibition by the Gasometer Oberhausen in cooperation with the Ocean Museum Germany, whose expertise formed the scientific basis.
